Communication with the school

Teachers and parents communicate through the Communication Book / Learner's Diary, which must be signed DAILY by both teacher and parent.

Notices are either printed or sent via SMS - parents must update their contact details to receive notices.

General Parents' Meetings

About us

Background:

The Academy was started in 1993 by the Grace Community Church. The Academy now has over 40 staff members and about 415 learners.

Registration

The Academy is registered as an NPO and is also fully registered with the IEB and the DoE, as an examination centre.

It is ACCREDITED by Umalusi as an Independent Provider of quality education and is affiliated with the Association of Christian Schools International (ACSI).

Curriculum:

We follow the National Curriculum, using the CAPS. We offer basic education for Grade R (5 years) up to Grade 12.

Our teaching is infused with Biblical integration in a fully Christian environment.

Our teacher-pupil ratio is 1:25 (Jr) and 1:20 (Sec).

General Information

Admission to our school

The following documents should be submitted together with the ONLINE application form for admission:

- Copy of learner's Birth Certificate (and Study Permit, where applicable)
- Copy of Vaccination Card (compulsory for Grades R to 5)
- Transfer letter and latest School Report from previous school
- Copies of parents' or guardian's ID's
- Proof of income (pay slips and/or bank statement) may be required

Fees

- ⇒ Placement Test Fee: R250 (non-refundable)
- ⇒ *Enrolment fee: R1250 once-off
- ⇒ *Book levy: R800 (FP), R1000 (IP) & R1200 (FET) per annum
- ⇒ School development levy : R1200 per annum
- ⇒ Computers (Grade1-9): R600 per annum
- ⇒ Extras include Extra English and Computers
- *Enrolment fee and Book levy are payable on registration.

School fees

- ⇒ 4 payment options are available
- ⇒ Pay for only 11 months (Jan to Nov)
- ⇒ Latest Fees schedule will be attached to the application form

Stationery & Learning support material

All textbooks and other learning support material are supplied by the school—costs are covered by the Book Levy. Learners bring own stationery (pens, calculator, crayons, ruler, etc.) Lost or torn textbooks are replaced and charged on student account.

School Uniform

Girls: Navy-blue skirts or skorts, white shirts and white socks.

Boys: Grey trousers, white shirts and grey socks.

Sport: Navy-blue golf T-shirts with school badge or vest and navy-blue shorts.

Navy-blue V-neck jersey and **for Seniors only**, Navy blazers (with badge) and Navy striped-on-Maroon ties.

Tracksuits: Navy with white and maroon side stripe and badge.

Grade R: Navy-blue shorts and Maroon T-shirts with school badge.

Grade 1-3: Navy-blue shorts and T-shirts with school badge.

Selected uniform items are to be purchased from the school. All other uniform items are obtainable from MGD and other shops.

School Programmes

- GROW Reading / Spelling programme (Gr R to 3).
- Each learner has at least 1 hour of computer lessons per week.
- Extra English, Afrikaans and Math lessons are also offered.
- Ask Archie, E-school and other online programmes available.

After Care Facility:

- Provided by Grace Aftercare Service at a nominal charge.
- Available till late—pick-up time can be negotiated.

Extra Curricular Activities

Sports:

Outdoor: Volleyball, Netball, Soccer, Hockey and Athletics
Indoor: Chess and Table Tennis.

Tuesdays & Thursdays are used for sports activities.

We also have music, dance, art and other extra mural activities on offer, some by external service providers.

School trips and Educational Excursions:

Each learner must go on at least one trip each year. Parents will be notified in time when this is organized.
